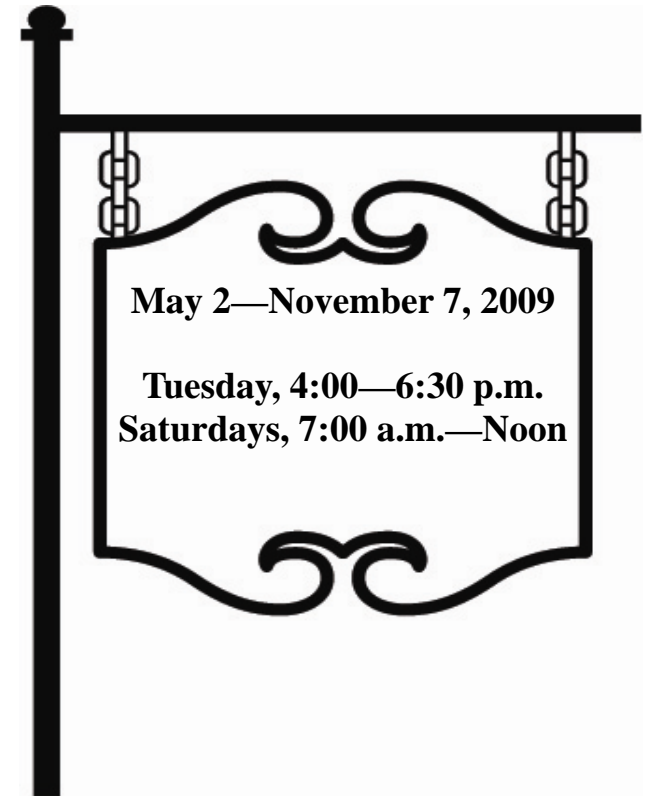

Mix and mingle with Downtown Jeffersontown merchants. See what products and services this Historic District has to offer.



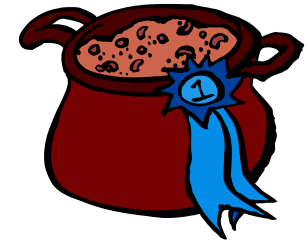
August 15th—Grilling Day
