

**CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN, KENTUCKY
MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 25, 2010
12:30 P.M.**

Mayor Clay S. Foreman called the Special Meeting of the Jeffersontown City Council to order at 12:30 P.M. The following Councilmembers were present: Kay Ackerson, Anita Johnson, Ray Perkins, Daniel Ruckriegel, Carol Pike, David Quinlan and Pam Ware. Councilmember Bill Dieruf was absent. Also present Fred E. Fischer, City Attorney, and Jim Leidgen, Clerk-Treasurer.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Foreman provided the City Council with a power point presentation of the proposed Budget and Appropriations for the City of Jeffersontown for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011. A discussion followed with no final action taken. In summary, Mayor Foreman commented that the proposal provides for a balanced Budget of \$18,145,185.00 in Revenues and \$18,034,624.00 in Expenditures, with no raise in the property tax rate, no lay-offs of staff and no reduction in services. Mayor Foreman distributed a copy of the Budget proposal to the City Council for their review and consideration and asked that they please call him before the next Council Meeting should they have any questions, comments or suggestions regarding the proposed Budget.
