MARCH IS SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS MONTH.

Please review the following information to make sure you are ready for any problems which may arise. Every house and apartment should have at least the following types of emergency Supplies:

PORTABLE RADIO WITH BATTERIES
FIRST AID KIT
FIRE EXTINGUISHER(s)
SMOKE DETECTOR(s) (check your batteries)
CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR(s)
DRINKING WATER
CANNED FOODS AND NON-ELECTRIC CAN OPENER
FLASHLIGHT(s) WITH BATTERIES



It is recommended to have a home emergency plan in place for fires, storms, earthquakes, and there should be house numbers posted on your house. These numbers should be at least three inches by two inches in standard form, (10410) - no script (ten thousand four hundred ten)
