## BLOCK WATCH NEWSLETTER MARCH 2015

THIS IS OUR ANNUAL REMINDER: MARCH IS SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS MONTH. PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE READY FOR ANY PROBLEMS, WHICH MAY ARISE.

Every house and apartment should have at least the following types of emergency supplies:

- FLASHLIGHT(s) WITH BATTERIES
- PORTABLE RADIO WITH BATTERIES
- CANDLES WITH HOLDER, MATCHES
- FIRST AID KIT
- FIRE EXTINGUISHER(s)
- SMOKE DETECTOR(s)
- CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR(s)
- DRINKING WATER
- CANNED FOODS AND NON-ELECTRIC CAN OPENER

There should be a home emergency plan in effect for fires, storms, earthquakes, and medical emergencies.

The telephones in each home should be equipped with an emergency telephone sticker listing the POLICE, FIRE AND EMS. The phone stickers for Jeffersontown Police can be obtained from the Jeffersontown Police Department at 10410 Taylorsville Rd. Each sticker should have your address listed on it. DO NOT depend on your memory during a crisis, you can easily forget who you are and where you live.

There should be house numbers posted on your house. These numbers should be at least three inches by two inches in standard Arabic form, (10410) - no script (ten thousand four hundred ten). The larger the number, the better. Also, make sure the numbers are contrasting colors to the color of the house. During past snow emergencies, numbers painted on curbs and mailboxes were useless. Snow plows covered mailboxes and in some cases, mailboxes were knocked down. Please post your numbers on the house!
