Fire safety is the focus this month. Below is a list of things you can do to prepare for a fire.

- Plan two escape routes out of each room.
- Practice fire drills at least twice a year.
- Stay low to the ground when escaping a fire.
- Never open doors that are hot. In a fire, feel the bottom of the door with the palm of your hand. If it is hot, do not open the door. Find another way out.
- Install smoke detectors on every level of your home. Clean & test them at least once a month.
- Change batteries twice a year, in the spring and fall when daylight savings time changes.
- Keep a whistle in each bedroom to awaken household in case of a fire.
- Check electrical outlets. Do not overload outlets.
- Purchase and learn how to use a fire extinguisher (5lb, A-B-C type).
- Have a collapsible ladder on each upper floor of your house.
- Consider installing home sprinklers.
