RUMPKE GIVES TIPS ON PREPARING LARGE ITEMS FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Completing a major household cleaning feels great! If you have finished a big cleaning project and have some large items ready for disposal, the City of Jeffersontown's waste contractor is ready to help.

We enjoy a good working relationship with Rumpke Waste & Recycling, and we appreciate services provided to our citizens. One of those is large item removal. Rumpke accepts one large item per customer per week. If you have items to be collected, here's how it works:

Follow these steps

- Call Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 at least 24 hours prior to your collection day to schedule a large item pickup.
- Mattresses, box springs and upholstered items must be completely wrapped in plastic and sealed. Plastic wrap and duct tape work well.
- Items with large pieces of glass (mirrors, tables, etc.) must be wrapped in plastic and sealed to contain any broken glass.
- Freon-containing appliances require special handling prior to collection. Please call Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 for those instructions.

Please note: Tires, batteries, liquids, construction debris, flammable material, appliances with Freon and hazardous items are not accepted.

Acceptable Items

- Mattresses & box springs
- Furniture
- Appliances (without Freon)
- Large amounts of bagged trash
- Carpet
- Television sets
- Child play equipment (must be broken down into smaller pieces, no longer than 4 feet)
